



# Chimney and Felker Lake Recreation Sites

## Campsite Information

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Site Operator for the Chimney and Felker Lake Recreation Sites! In becoming a Site Operator, you will get to live on Chimney Lake in a rustic campground while getting to interact with a tight-knit community!



## Background:

The Chimney and Felker Lake Recreation Sites consist of 3 sunny campground sites: Felker Lake, Chimney North, and Chimney Center. They reside on 2 lakes (Chimney and Felker) that are right next to each other and are approximately 30 minutes southwest of Williams Lake.

The lakes are beautiful during the summer months, and you'll find them to be very popular with campers, fishers, and day-users. There's even a new disc golf course across the road from Chimney Center!

## Facilities:

**Felker Lake Recreation Site** provides 12 campsites each identified with a 4x6 number post. The day use site has 4 spots. The recreation site altogether has:

- 16 cement tables (with wood benches)
- 1 wood table
- 18 metal fire rings
- 3 wood pit toilets
- 4 double bear-proof garbage cans
- 1 single main gate
- 1 boat launch
- Day use parking area
- Various signage



**Chimney Lake North Recreation Site** provides 25 campsites each identified with a 4x6 number post. The day use site has 8 spots. The recreation site altogether has:

- 28 cement tables (with wood benches)
- 3 wood tables
- 25 metal fire rings
- 9 wood pit toilets
- 5 double bear-proof garbage cans
- 2 single main gates
- 1 boat launch
- 3 swim buoys
- Day use parking area
- 1 large kiosk
- Various signage



**Chimney Lake Center Recreation Site** provides 9 campsites and was designed to be a “group” camping” more than the individual sites, but it is not a rule. This recreation site has:

- 9 wood tables
- 9 metal fire rings
- 2 wood pit toilets
- 2 double bear-proof garbage cans
- 1 boat launch
- 2 swim buoys
- Various signage
- Disc golf parking
  - not available for camper or boater parking



### **Service Requirements:**

**Due to the volume of associated duties it is required that there are a minimum of two persons completing duties during peak times.**

**Operating Season:** May 1<sup>st</sup> – October 15<sup>th</sup>. Preparation work can start as soon as it’s snow-free.

**Peak Season:** June 1<sup>st</sup> – September 30<sup>th</sup>.

**Camping Fee:** \$15.00/party/night and \$7.50/party/night for seniors or persons with a disability

### **If needed, we will provide for you:**

- A portable garage
- A grey water tank
- Recycling containers if you wish to collect recycling

In choosing Campsite Operators at the Chimney and Felker Lake Recreation Sites, we use a ‘Weighted Criteria’ application form. This form uses a points system to account for experience and capability, and we offer the position to the person with the most points. So be sure to include everything you can! We also appreciate an attitude of satisfaction for a job well done, as well as public relations skills.
