

Hunting in B.C.

Welcome to the B.C. hunting portal, a one-stop website for hunters, and your gateway to a range of online information and services.

Hunting is a popular recreational activity for more than 100,000 British Columbians, draws tourists to our province from all over the world, and provides food and cultural activity for many of B.C.'s First Nations.

It's estimated that B.C.'s resident hunters and guide outfitters contribute \$350 million annually to the provincial economy, while a surcharge on licences is directed to the Habitat Conservation Trust Fund for conservation projects.

- Register for your [Fish & Wildlife ID](#): The FWID replaces the B.C. Hunter Number card and is required to purchase a hunting licence or apply for LEH. The FWID is not a card. You can either print it or download a copy onto your mobile device. You do not need to carry your FWID while you are hunting.
- Apply for your [B.C. Resident Hunting credentials](#): Your credentials provide proof that you are qualified to hunt in B.C.
- Apply for upcoming [Limited Entry Hunting](#) draws and track the status of your LEH applications. LEH are hunting opportunities determined by a random draw. Anyone with a valid FWID and hunting credentials can apply for LEH.
- You can still register for your FWID and apply for your credentials or LEH in person. Visit your nearest [Service BC](#), [FrontCounter BC](#) or [participating vendor](#).

You need a BCeID to access BC Hunting online.


- Go to gov.bc.ca/hunting





Step 6 – Review your Fish and Wildlife Profile


Your Profile homepage will display each time you sign back in to BC Hunting.
