



Dear LEH Hunter:

This letter is for hunters who received a Limited Entry Hunting (LEH) authorization for an antlerless elk in Management Units 7-12, 7-14, 7-14, or 7-25. The LEH authorization received allows the recipient to hunt antlerless elk in those areas on private land only, with permission of the land owner. It is recommended to obtain written permission from the landowner when hunting on private land. The Nechako Valley Regional Cattlemen's Association (NVRCA) - Environmental Stewardship Committee, is interested in helping Antlerless Elk LEH permit holders get in touch with landowners who are experiencing hay depredation losses and elk damages during this season.
