



Dear LEH Hunter:

This letter is for hunters who received a Limited Entry Hunting (LEH) authorization for an antlerless elk in Omineca Region, which includes the newly amalgamized hunt zones that are all restricted to private land only as follows:

Hunt Code – 2196 to 2198 – M.U. 7-02 (includes 7-02, 7-03, 7-04, 7-05, and 7-17)

Hunt Codes 2199 to 2201 – M.U. 7-07 (includes 7-07, 7-08, 7-09, 7-10, 7-15 and 7-24)

Hunt Codes 2202 to 2204 - M.U. 7-12 (includes 7-12, 7-13, 7-14 and 7-25)

Hunt Code 2205 (Youth) MU 7-07(includes 7-07, 7-08, 4-09, 7-10, 7-15 and 7-24)

Hunt Code 2206 (Youth) M.U. 7-12 (includes 7-12, 7-13, 7-14 and 7-25)

The LEH authorization received allows the recipient to hunt antlerless elk in those zones they are authorized, on private land only, with permission of the landowner. It is recommended to obtain written permission from the landowner when hunting on private land. The Nechako Valley Regional Cattlemen's Association (NVRCA) - Environmental Stewardship Committee, is interested in helping Antlerless Elk LEH permit holders get in touch with landowners who are experiencing hay depredation losses and elk damages during this season.
