



Dear LEH Hunter:

You are receiving this letter because you are a successful applicant for a LEH Mountain Goat hunt in Zone B of 5-04.

On June 26, 2014, the Supreme Court of Canada (SCC) granted the Tsilhqot'in Nation a declaration of aboriginal title. The map in Appendix A shows an area that includes the declared title area. As a result of the SCC decision, the status of these lands has changed and they are not publicly available for hunting at this time.

The LEH for Mountain Goat in Zone B of 5-04 is completely outside of the Tsilhqot'in title land (see map below in Appendix A); however access to this zone has been significantly reduced. If you wish to access Zone B of 5-04 for your hunt, you may still do so, but the Province advises you **not to enter** Tsilhqot'in title land.

Thank you for your cooperation and continued support as we work with the Tsilhqot'in Nation to fully understand the scope and implications of this decision.

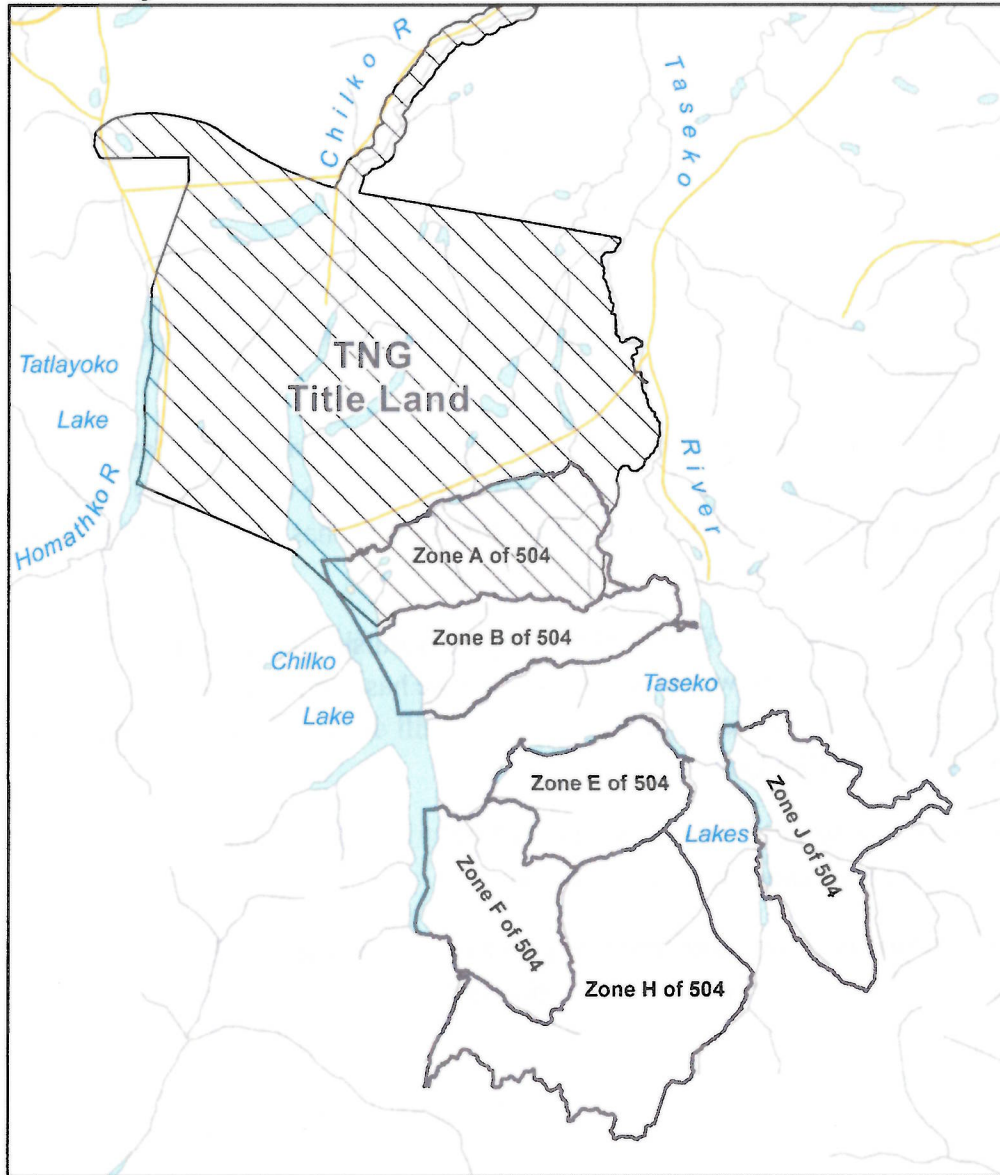
