You asked . . .

1. At what point is production measured?

Production is measured at the stage where the product is available for use (either on or off the mine site), or ready for input into the next process in the case where the next process falls outside of the jurisdiction of the mine inspectors. (This means material stock piled in the current year will be included in the current year fee.)

2. Our pit is not in operation. Do I have to fill out this form?

Yes. Until reclamation is complete and reclamation security is returned, you must continue to complete the forms and submit the fee. For information on how to have your security bond returned call your local Mines Branch Regional Office.

3. Is there a minimum fee?

Yes. All sand, gravel and quarry operators who hold a *Mines Act* permit are subject to the Mine Health and Safety Inspection fee. **In 2009 the minimum fee is \$100.00.**
