

## Changes to Royalty/Taxpayer Reporting Deadline Petroleum and Natural Gas Act

The royalty/taxpayer reporting deadline is changing to align with the allocation deadline posted in the Petrinex calendar. The purpose of the change is to eliminate discrepancies and warnings caused by the gap in the timing of submissions.

Currently, the royalty/taxpayer reporting deadline is the last business day of the month. **Effective September 2021**, the deadline will be the same date as the allocation deadline posted in the Petrinex calendar.

The **new reporting deadlines** for the final months of 2021 will be:

- September (August Production) – Monday, September 27
- October (September Production) – Monday, October 25
- November (October Production) – Thursday, November 25
- December (November Production) – Wednesday, December 29

The timing of the two royalty/taxpayer non-compliance warnings generated from Petrinex each month will also be changing slightly. The first warning will be run 5 days before the new reporting deadline. The second warning will be run 2 days before the deadline, aligning with the Allocations Ensure Complete Warning Report.
