under the Property Transfer Tax Act

INSTRUCTIONS

- Use this form when you claim a bankruptcy exemption on your web filing property transfer tax return.
If this is a transfer from the trustee in bankruptcy (hereafter referred to as the trustee) back to the bankrupt person (hereafter referred to as the bankrupt) and no consideration is paid to the trustee for the transfer, this declaration must be printed and signed by both the trustee and the bankrupt.
If this is a transfer to the trustee, or to the spouse or former spouse of the bankrupt, no signatures are required.
Scan your completed form, save it on your computer and attach it to your web filing property transfer tax return.
