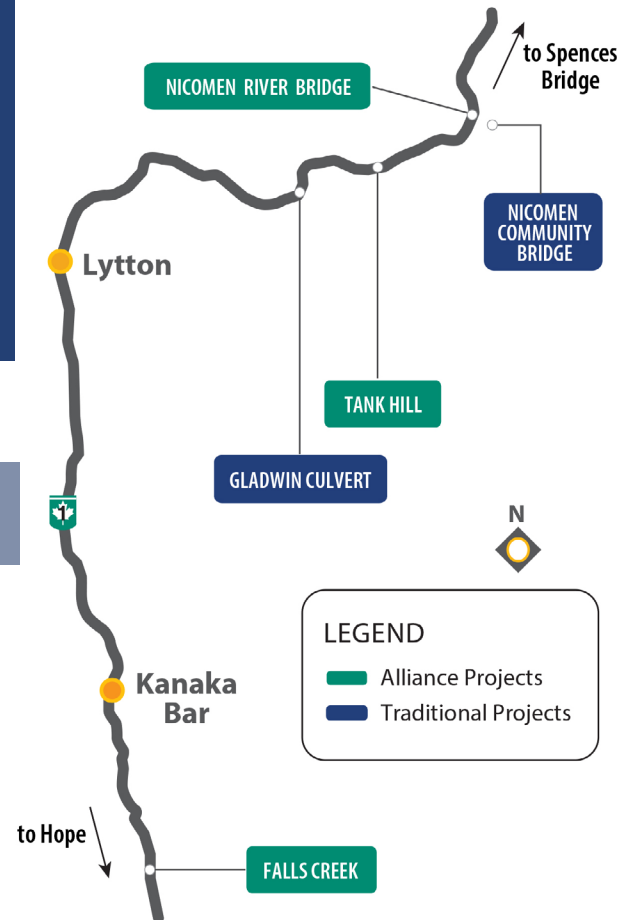

INFRASTRUCTURE UPDATE PREPARED FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS

Permanent repairs are in progress at 4 locations on Highway 1 to return the highway to full capacity following damage caused by heavy rains in the November 2021 Atmospheric River Event.

HONOURING THE CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE OF LAND ALONG HIGHWAY 1

The Province is committed to building safe, resilient infrastructure and honouring the cultural significance of the land to First Nation and local communities. In this spirit, the new bridge at Falls Creek, which fully reopened this summer, was officially named Cəᖃᖅ Cixᖅ (Check-Chow) Bridge. Naming the bridge involved local communities, including Kanaka Bar and Boothroyd, with support from Nlaka'pamux communities.

NICOMEN RIVER BRIDGE

Project Overview

Nicomen River Bridge project is 16 km east of Lytton.

Status: In construction, on schedule

Update:

- Channel resiliency improvements and bridge deck complete.
- Grade lowering activities planned for September.
- Expect minor delays and single lane alternating traffic.
- Traffic will start using the new bridge in late September with the full two lane opening anticipated in mid-October.

TANK HILL

Project Overview

Tank Hill project is 13 km east of Lytton.

Status: In construction, on schedule

Update:

The project team is working to address challenges with traffic at Tank Hill. Safety and mobility through the site and along the corridor is our number one priority.

- 20 minute closures for rock scaling are now complete.
- Single lane alternating traffic will be in effect for detour construction which will improve travel times.
- The project team is proactively coordinating with the railway to reduce delays and continually reviewing traffic control setup and site conditions to make improvements.
