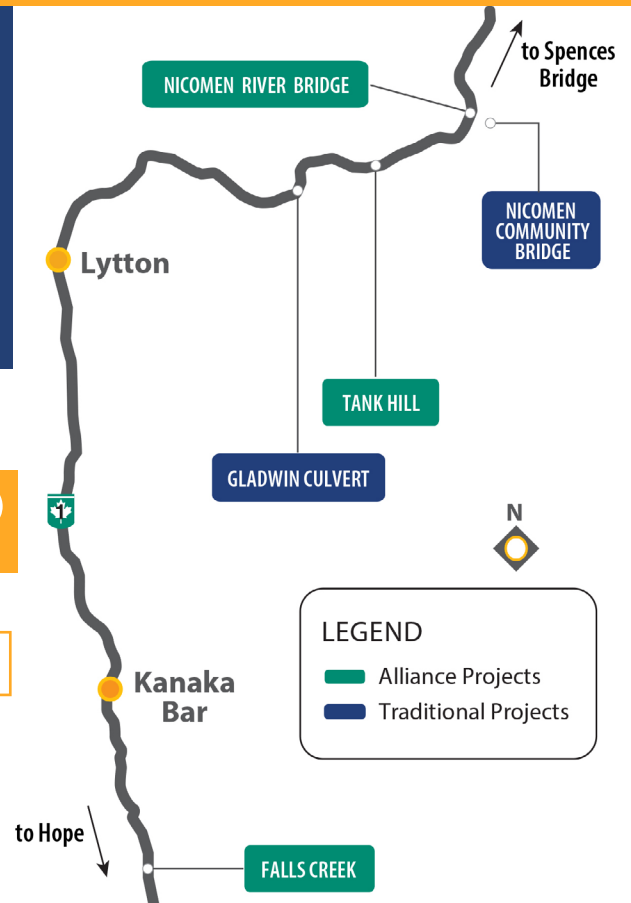

Project Overview

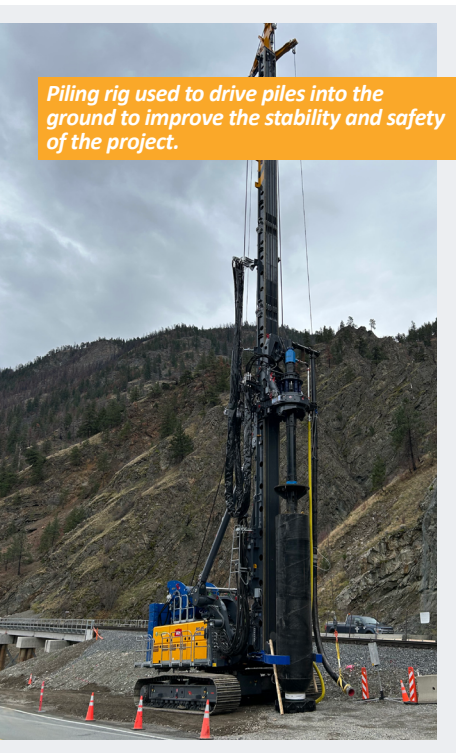
The Nicomen River Bridge project is located 16 km east of Lytton.

Status: On schedule for completion in December 2024

Update:

- Two lanes are now open on the highway bridge
- The temporary single lane bridge has been removed
- Expect short periods of single lane alternating traffic to allow for minor repairs
- Planting, minor repairs and other activities will continue on site until December 2024

TANK HILL



Project Overview

The Tank Hill project is 13 km east of Lytton.

Status: On schedule for completion in December 2025

Update:

- The project team appreciates the patience of drivers through the site as traffic control plans are improved. Safety and mobility through the site is a priority and the team is working hard to keep delays to a minimum.
- Feedback from community members and drivers in the corridor is incorporated into traffic management to improve communication and predictability of delays.
