PERMANENT REPAIR UPDATE

Permanent repairs are underway on Highway 1 to return the highway to full capacity. Construction is in progress for the Tank Hill project and design work is being completed for the Gladwin Culvert and Nicomen Community Bridge.


Project overview

The Tank Hill project (14 km east of Lytton) is constructing an overpass that will separate the highway and railway at different heights to improve safety and reliability for highway and rail traffic. This will also improve the structure's ability to withstand extreme weather and flooding in the future.

The conceptual drawing and photo to the right show the approximate height of the future overpass.

Work taking place in February

Construction is progressing quickly. In February and into March, foundation work is taking place to support the new bridge structure. Drivers through the site will see cranes installing large concrete supports and caps that will hold the future bridge.









TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Drivers at Tank Hill should be prepared for potential delays on site and watch for:

- A two-lane detour with intermittent single lane alternating traffic to accommodate detour construction.
- Updated **traffic control signage** showing changes on site.

Projects in design and planning

Planning and design work is in progress for the Gladwin Culvert and Nicomen Community Bridge projects. Design work for both projects will be completed in 2025, with construction to follow.

NICOMEN COMMUNITY BRIDGE




Location
