## PERMANENT REPAIR UPDATE

Permanent repairs are underway on Highway 1 to return the highway to full capacity. Construction is in progress for the Tank Hill project and contractors have been selected for the replacement of Gladwin Culvert and Sackum Overhead Bridge.

## Tank Hill bridge open to traffic

The new bridge to separate highway and train traffic at Tank Hill, 14 km east of Lytton, is now open to two lanes of traffic, providing a safer, more reliable route for travelers and eliminating delays caused by trains crossing the highway. In September, works completed included paving the road approaches, line painting, and installing signage, safety reflectors and safety barriers. Overnight closures in mid-September helped workers complete this work more safely and efficiently. The work to remove the detour will start in late September and will be completed by late October. This will include completion of the truck climbing lane which is the third lane on the bridge.

All remaining work on the project is expected to be complete in early November
