
CONSTRUCTION STARTING SOON

Design work for the permanent repairs on the first section of damaged sites (sites 1 to 8) is complete. Construction on these sites will begin in the summer and is expected to be complete by fall 2024. The permanent repairs will improve safe access for residents and are designed to withstand future weather-related events. Be prepared for potential traffic delays throughout the summer.

Work on the sites 20 to 22 in the western end of the corridor near Spences Bridge will start in late 2024.

PERMANENT ROAD REPAIR TIMELINE

November 2021

Atmospheric River event washes out more than 25 sections of Highway 8

November 2022

• Emergency work is completed and Highway 8 reopens to the public

Spring 2024

 Planning and design work for permanent repairs on sites 1 to 8 and sites 20 to 22

Summer 2024

- Construction starts on permanent repairs on sites 1 to 8
- Delivery team selected for design and construction work at sites 9 and 10

Fall 2024

- Construction is completed on sites 1 to 8
- Construction starts on permanent repairs on sites 20 to 22
- Planning and design work starts for sites 9 and 10 and all remaining sites

Spring 2025

- Permanent repairs at remaining sites begin
- To minimize disruptions in the corridor, construction at each site will be staggered until all work is completed in winter 2027

Winter 2027

Construction is completed
