

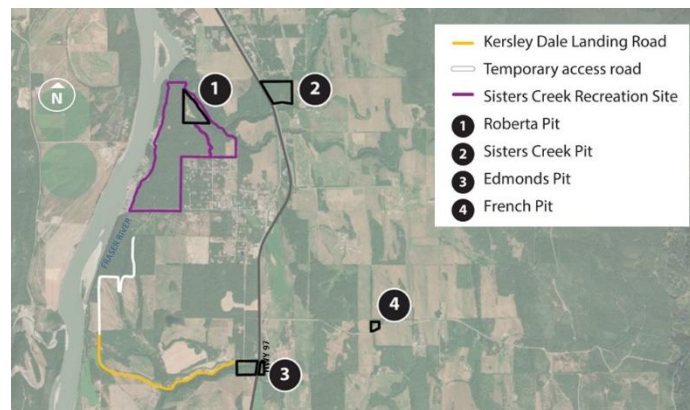
PROJECT UPDATE – November 2023

Kersley-Dale Landing Road

The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure is in the final stages of determining a long-term restoration option that will provide a safe and climate resilient solution for Kersley-Dale Landing Road.

As part of project development, the project team has heard concerns from the community about the use of gravel from Roberta Pit, located beside the Sisters Creek Recreation Site, and has the following locations as alternatives to consider: Sisters Creek Pit, Edmonds Pit and French Pit.

The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure is optimistic that one of the alternate sources can be used for the project instead of Roberta Pit. Testing is underway for alternate sources of material for the project.
