## Single-lane alternating traffic on Quesnel-Hixon Road near Ahbau Creek Bridge

### June 2024

From June 10 to 17, 2024, traffic on a 100-meter segment of Quesnel-Hixon Road on either side of Ahbau Creek Bridge will be reduced to single-lane alternating from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. This change is necessary for crews to conduct geotechnical drilling investigations. Two boreholes will be drilled on either side of the bridge to assess subsurface soil, rock, and groundwater conditions to inform project planning.

Traffic control will be on site to direct drivers and pedestrians during work hours. Please drive with caution.

## What to Expect

#### Timing

Drilling will start on June 10 and continue for approximately one week. Crews may also be seen in the project area prior to the start of work to confirm drill hole locations.

#### **Hours of Work**

This traffic change will be in effect from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.



Drilling will be conducted near Ahbau Creek Bridge.

#### Traffic

Traffic control will be on site to direct drivers and pedestrians during work hours. Work areas will be well-signed.

Two-lane traffic will resume outside of operational hours.

#### Impacts

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to these temporary traffic changes and the movement of crews and equipment. Nearby residents may hear noise associated with drilling activities.

In the event of an emergency, drilling equipment will be moved to allow emergency vehicles to pass through the work area.
