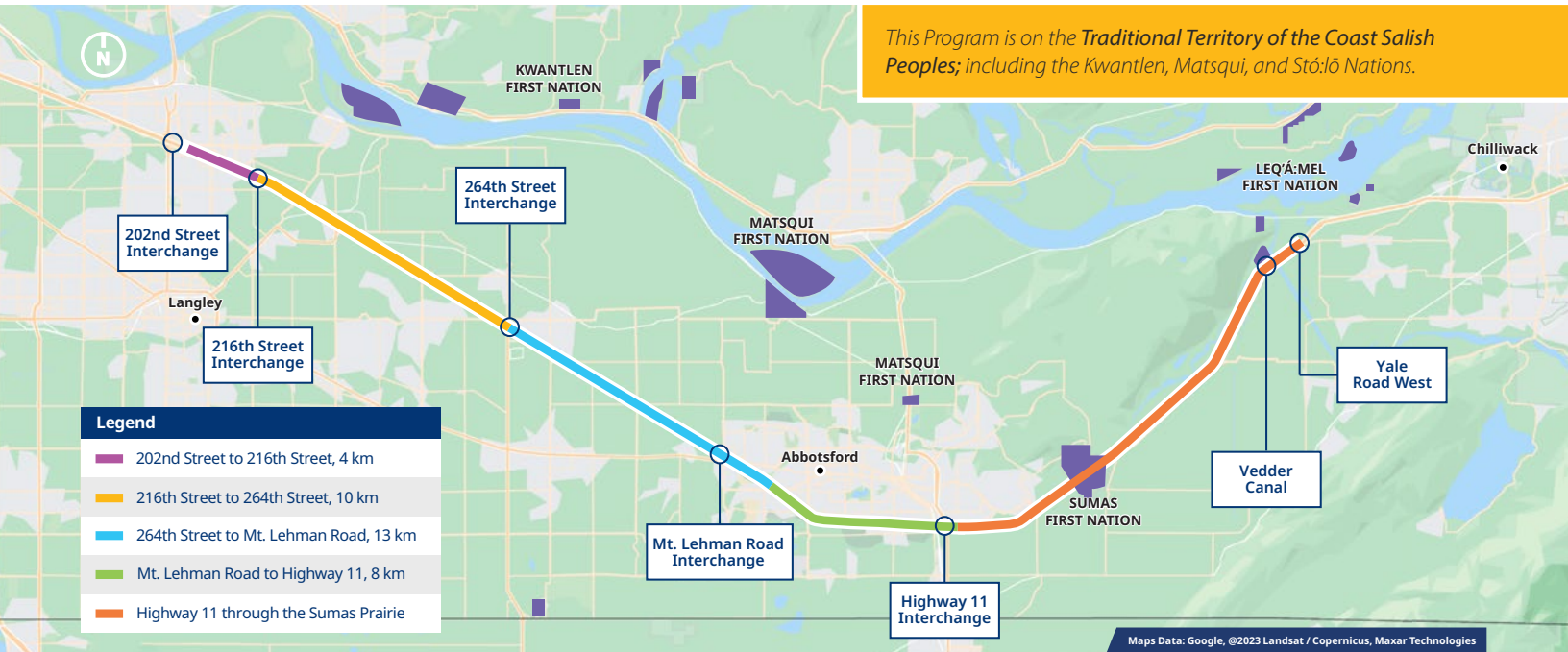




The Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program is improving safety, reliability and capacity between 216th Street in Langley through to Chilliwack. Highway improvements will meet the needs of a growing region, improve travel and transit services for people in the Fraser Valley and facilitate efficient goods movement.



Why It's Needed

The improvements are helping to meet needs in four key areas:

- Congestion: Improving travel times and reliability in both directions.
- Economic development: Supporting efficient goods movement.
- Population growth: Adapting to the growing number of people living and travelling in the region.
- Safety: Reducing the number and severity of crashes on the corridor.

Program Opportunities

- Improved transit services.
- More choices for active transportation (walking, biking rolling).
- Improved climate resiliency.
- Supporting Transit Oriented Development – the creation of complete, liveable and sustainable communities by building more homes near transit and services.
- Affordable housing.
