

# Traffic Detour Notice

## Upcoming Traffic Detour at the Highway 1 - 264th Street Interchange Project

### For motorists heading to Highway 1 westbound:

Effective March 15, 2025, the northeast loop ramp, which currently allows motorists traveling north on 264th Street to merge onto Highway 1 westbound toward Vancouver, will be closed.

Motorists will be redirected to a newly widened intersection on the north side of the 264th Street Interchange at 56 Avenue and 264th Street. A new left-turn signal will be added, allowing motorists traveling north on 264th Street to turn left onto the existing westbound on-ramp to Highway 1.




## For motorists heading to Highway 1 eastbound:

Effective March 22, 2025, the southwest loop ramp, which currently allows motorists traveling south on 264th Street to merge onto Highway 1 eastbound toward Hope, will be closed.

Motorists will be redirected to a newly widened intersection on the south side of the 264th Street Interchange at 56 Avenue and 264th Street. A left-turn signal will be added, allowing motorists traveling south on 264th Street to turn left onto the existing eastbound on-ramp to Highway 1.
