



## Traffic pattern changes at 232nd Street

As part of the 232nd Street Interchange Project, as early as April 7, 2026, new traffic signals will control how drivers exit and enter Highway 1 eastbound at 232nd Street.

Eastbound Highway 1 drivers wanting to exit on 232nd Street will now use the existing northbound exit, which has been upgraded with a traffic signal to accommodate southbound left turns off the ramp.

Similarly, drivers wanting to travel eastbound on Highway 1 from 232nd Street will now use the new traffic signal to turn left onto the highway on-ramp.

The existing southwest loop ramp and eastbound to southbound off-ramp are being closed.

Local traffic from 72nd Ave will use the newly paved L90 Access Road connecting to 70A Ave.
