



Traffic diversions on Highway 1 between Glover Road and 248th Street

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of overnight, weekend traffic diversions westbound on Highway 1 between Glover Road and 248th Street, on Friday, April 24 and Saturday, April 25, 2026.

These traffic-pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to safely complete drainage pipe replacements on Highway 1 and are dependent on good weather. This work is a key component of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program.

Westbound on Highway 1 between Glover Road and 248th Street	From 8:30 p.m. at night to 10:30 a.m. the following morning on Friday, April 24 and Saturday, April 25	<p>Westbound Highway 1 lane diversions. The diversions will implement a highway crossover, to allow traffic to flow in both directions in the eastbound highway lanes.</p> <p>During the diversions, the westbound exit to 232nd St will be closed. The on-ramp to Highway 1 will remain open. Work is weather dependent, so exact timing of the diversions could shift.</p>

A reduced speed limit of 80 km/h will be in place. Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and traffic-control personnel and watch for roadside workers. Please allow for additional travel time through the area when diversions are underway.
