# Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program

## Single Lane Alternating Traffic on Livingstone Avenue

As part of the broader program to widen and improve Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, the Ministry of Transportation and Transit will be relocating a culvert owned by the City of Abbotsford and adding a new storm drain along Livingstone Avenue.

This work is needed to accommodate Highway 1 widening. By diverting runoff to Fishtrap Creek, it will also help to minimize the risk of flooding in the surrounding area during heavy rains.

To complete this work, 24-hour single lane alternating traffic (SLAT) will be in place on Livingstone Avenue between Mall Access Road and Gardner Park Access starting as early as May 11.

We anticipate SLAT to remain in place until the end of June. Livingstone Avenue will also require a temporary full closure for a few days in mid-June for connection work. Specific dates and details to be shared closer to the start of this work.

During construction, access to Gardner Park and neighbouring condominium complexes and businesses will be maintained. Thank you for supporting these businesses during construction.

Please plan ahead and allow for extra travel time through the area. Follow all traffic signage and control to help to keep workers and your fellow road users safe.



## Pile installation at the Highway 1 Fishtrap Creek Structure

In addition, as early as May 4, pile installation will begin at the Fishtrap Creek structure adjacent to the westbound lanes of Highway 1, near Gardner Park. This work is also part of the efforts to widen Highway 1, and is needed to support the bridge at this creek crossing. Work will occur weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., with some Saturday work if needed. Area residents may experience some additional daytime noise or vibration during this period. We anticipate this pile installation to finish by the end of June.
