
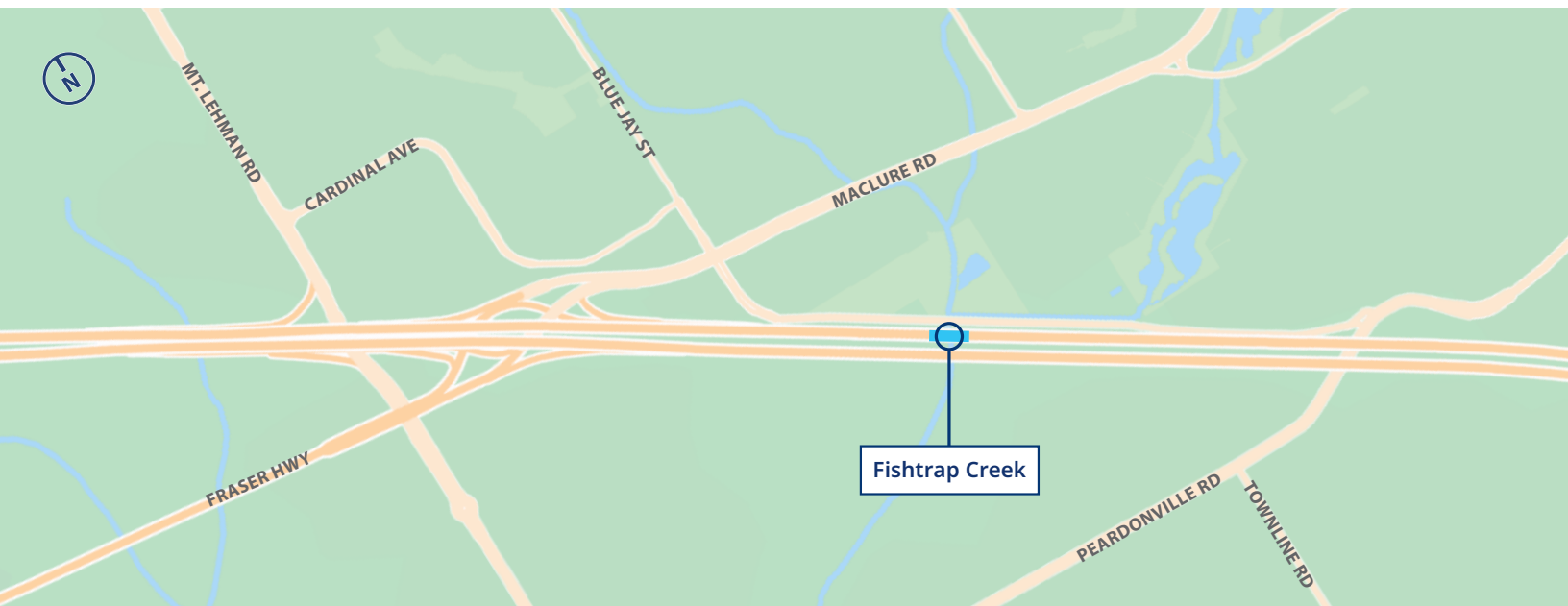




## Traffic pattern change - Highway 1 at Fishtrap Creek

As part of the broader project to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers travelling on Highway 1 can expect new traffic pattern changes along the corridor.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
 Westbound on Highway 1 at Fishtrap Creek.	Starting as early as early as May 8, 2026.	Lane shift into the median adjacent to the Fishtrap Creek structure.



These changes are in addition to ongoing overnight lane closures and are needed for the safe and efficient construction of projects that are part of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program. A reduced speed limit of

80 km/h will be in place. Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and watch for roadside workers.
