



Off-ramp closures on Highway 1 at 232nd Street

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of overnight off-ramp closures at 232nd Street.

These closures are necessary to allow crews to safely complete concrete deck pours on the new 232nd Street structure. This work is a key component of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program.

Highway 1 232nd Street westbound off-ramp	Thursday, June 18th: 8:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning	The westbound exit to 232nd Street will be closed. The on-ramp to Highway 1 will remain open.
Highway 1 232nd Street eastbound off-ramp	Monday, June 22nd: 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning	The eastbound exit to 232nd Street will be closed. The on-ramp to Highway 1 will remain open.

Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and traffic-control personnel and watch for roadside workers. Please allow for additional travel time through the area.

Note: FIFA World Cup may also impact traffic volumes on area roads.
