



Traffic diversions on Highway 1 between Glover Road and 248th Street

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of overnight, weekend traffic diversions eastbound on Highway 1 between Glover Road and 248th Street.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to safely complete concrete deck pours on the new 232nd Street structure. This work is a key component of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
Westbound on Highway 1 between Glover Road and 248th Street	Thursday, July 2nd: from 8:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning	Westbound Highway 1 lane diversions. The diversions will implement a highway crossover to allow traffic to flow in both directions in the eastbound highway lanes. During the diversion, the westbound exit to 232nd Street will be closed. The on-ramp to Highway 1 will remain open.
Eastbound on Highway 1 between Glover Road and 248th Street	Monday, July 6th: from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning	Eastbound fast lane closure.

Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and traffic-control personnel and watch for roadside workers. Please allow for additional travel time through the area.

Note: FIFA World Cup may also impact traffic volumes on area roads.
