

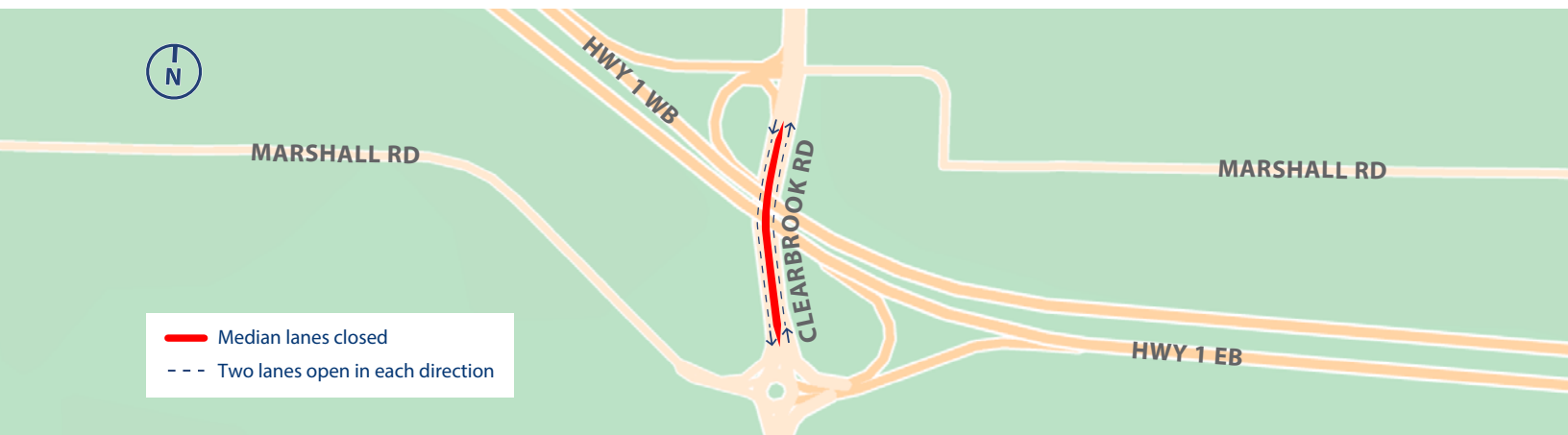


## Temporary lane reduction on the Clearbrook Road structure over Highway 1

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of a temporary lane reduction on the Clearbrook Road structure over Highway 1.

This traffic pattern change is necessary to allow crews to complete deck modifications to the structure. This work is a key component of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
Northbound and southbound on the Clearbrook Road structure over Highway 1	As early as Monday, July 6, 2026 to Saturday, July 18, 2026	<p>The northbound and southbound median lanes will be closed, reducing the structure to two lanes in each direction.</p> <p>Drivers should plan for additional congestion, including on the off-ramps from Highway 1 and on either end of the structure.</p>



Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and traffic-control personnel and watch for roadside workers. Please allow for additional travel time through the area.

*Note: FIFA World Cup may also impact traffic volumes on area roads.*
