



Traffic pattern change - eastbound Highway 1 at 264th Street

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of a traffic pattern change on Highway 1 at 264th Street.

This traffic pattern change is necessary to allow crews to complete improvements to Highway 1 eastbound, including drainage, utility relocation and structure demolition. This work is a key component of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program.

Eastbound Highway 1 at the 264th Street Interchange	As early as Saturday, July 11 until November 2026	• Eastbound Highway 1 lanes will shift north of the median. • The eastbound off-ramp to 264th Street (exit 73) will start approximately 1 km west of its current location. • Emergency services turnarounds are unchanged.

Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and traffic-control personnel and watch for roadside workers. Please allow for additional travel time through the area.

Note: FIFA World Cup may also impact traffic volumes on area roads.
