



Traffic pattern changes on Highway 1 westbound between 248th Street and Glover Road

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes westbound on Highway 1 between 248th Street and Glover Road.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to install drainage infrastructure and other improvements on Highway 1.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
Westbound on Highway 1 between 248th Street and Glover Road	Thursday, July 9th: from 8:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning	Westbound Highway 1 lane diversions. The diversions will implement a highway crossover to allow traffic to flow in both directions in the eastbound highway lanes. During the diversion, both the westbound on- and off-ramps at 232nd Street will be closed.
	Starting Friday, July 10th until mid-September	New westbound on-ramp configuration from 232nd Street. Lane pattern shift for westbound Highway 1 drivers at the 232nd Street bridge structure.

Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and traffic-control personnel and watch for roadside workers. Please allow for additional travel time through the area.

Note: FIFA World Cup may also impact traffic volumes on area roads.
