



Traffic pattern changes on Highway 1 westbound between 248th Street and Glover Road

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes westbound on Highway 1 between 248th Street and Glover Road.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to complete work on the 232nd Street structure deck.

Westbound on Highway 1 between 248th Street and Glover Road	Monday, July 13th to Thursday, July 16th: from 8:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning Friday, July 17th: from 8:30 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. the following morning	The westbound exit to 232nd Street and westbound slow lane will be closed. The on-ramp to Highway 1 will remain open.
	Monday, July 20th to Thursday, July 23rd: from 8:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning Friday, July 24th: from 8:30 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. the following morning	Westbound Highway 1 lane diversions. The diversions will implement a highway crossover to allow traffic to flow in both directions in the eastbound highway lanes. During the diversion, both the westbound on- and off-ramps at 232nd Street will be closed.

Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and watch for roadside workers. Please allow for additional travel time through the area.

Note: FIFA World Cup may also impact traffic volumes on area roads.
