



Traffic pattern changes on Highway 11 and Highway 1

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes on both Highway 1 and Highway 11.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to prepare for upcoming demolition activities as part of the Highway 11 Interchange Project.

Eastbound on Highway 1 at Highway 11	Nightly from Monday, July 27 to Thursday, July 30: 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. the following morning	The Highway 1 eastbound off-ramp to Highway 11 will be closed. The on-ramp to Highway 1 will remain open. Detour route will be provided.
Westbound on Highway 1 at Highway 11	Nightly from Tuesday, August 4 to Tuesday, August 11: 8:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. the following morning (9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights)	The westbound on-ramp to Highway 1 from Highway 11 southbound/northbound will be closed. The off-ramp to Highway 11 will remain open. Detour route will be provided.
Highway 11 under Highway 1	Nightly from Tuesday, August 4 to Tuesday, August 11: 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. the following morning (9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights)	Highway 11 will be reduced to one lane in each direction.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage and traffic-control personnel, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.
