



Traffic pattern changes on Highway 1 eastbound between 248th Street and Glover Road

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes eastbound on Highway 1 between 248th Street and Glover Road.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to complete work on the 232nd Street structure deck.

Eastbound on Highway 1 between 248th Street and Glover Road	Tuesday, August 4th to Friday, August 21st: from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning. (7:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights)	Eastbound Highway 1 lane diversions. The diversions will implement a highway crossover to allow traffic to flow in both directions in the westbound highway lanes. During the diversion, the eastbound off-ramp will be closed. The eastbound on-ramp will remain open.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.
