



Temporary lane reduction on the Clearbrook Road structure over Highway 1

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of a temporary lane reduction on the Clearbrook Road structure over Highway 1.

This traffic pattern change is necessary to allow crews to complete deck modifications to the structure. This work is a key component of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
Northbound and southbound on the Clearbrook Road structure over Highway 1	As early as Monday, August 10 to mid-November	Traffic on the structure will be reduced to two lanes in each direction. Drivers should plan for additional congestion, including on the off-ramps from Highway 1 and on either end of the structure.



Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.

Please note, construction timelines are subject to change due to weather and other field conditions.
