

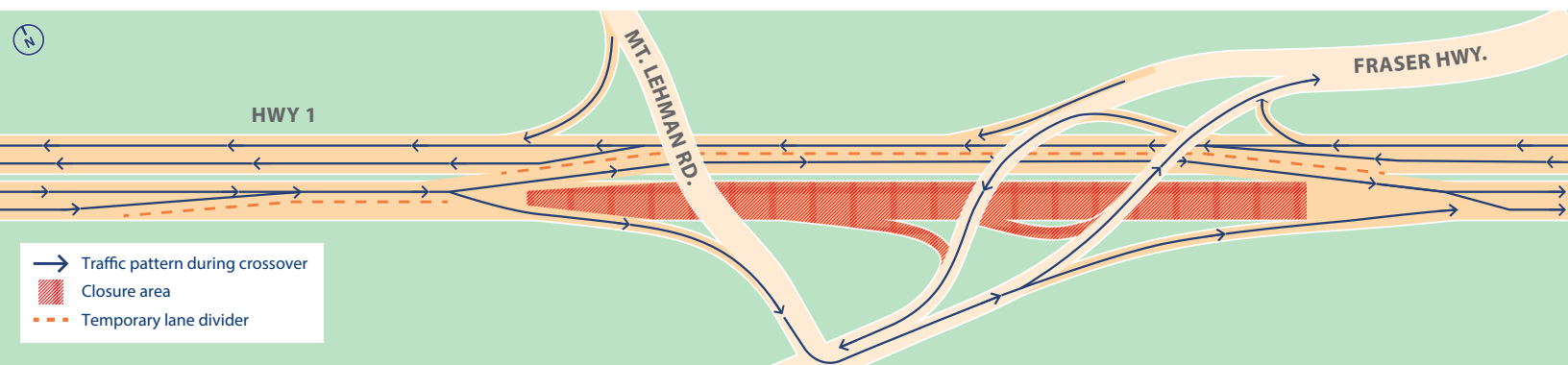


Traffic pattern changes on Highway 1 at Mt Lehman Road

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes eastbound on Highway 1, from Mt Lehman Road to Fraser Highway.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to safely install girders for the expanded Mt Lehman structure.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
Eastbound on Highway 1, from west of Mt Lehman Road to east of Fraser Highway	Multiple nights, from as early as Monday, August 17 through Saturday, August 29: Sunday-Thursday: 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Friday-Saturday: 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.	Eastbound traffic will crossover to flow in both directions in the westbound lanes (one lane in each direction). The southbound off-ramp at Mt Lehman Road will remain open. Northbound Mt Lehman Road and eastbound Fraser Highway traffic will have detours available. On-ramp access is unaffected.



Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage, and watch for roadside workers.
