



Single lane alternating traffic on 264th Street

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of overnight single lane alternating traffic on 264th Street between the Highway 1 westbound off-ramp and 52nd Avenue (south of Highway 1).

This traffic pattern change is necessary to allow crews to safely reconstruct the southbound lane on 264th Street. This work is a key component of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program.

Please note, traffic on 264th Street will run on gravel during the day while this work is completed.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage and traffic-control personnel, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.
