Traffic pattern changes on Highway 11 at Highway 1

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes on Highway 1 at Highway 11.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to prepare for upcoming demolition activities as part of the Highway 11 Interchange Project.

Westbound on Highway 1 at Highway 11	Multiple nights, from as early as Monday, August 24 through Monday, September 14. Sunday-Thursday: 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Friday-Saturday: 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.	The Highway 11 westbound on-ramp to Highway 1 will be closed. The off-ramp will remain open. Detour route will be provided.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage and traffic-control personnel, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.
