Traffic pattern changes on 264th Street at Highway 1

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes on 264th Street at Highway 1.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to prepare for demolition of the existing 264th Street structure.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
264th Street at Highway 1	As early as, Saturday, August 29, 2026 at 9:00 p.m.	Northbound and southbound traffic on 264th Street will be shifted west onto a newly constructed roadway and bridge. The existing bridge and lanes on 264th Street will be permanently closed. Single lane alternating traffic will be in place overnight on Saturday, August 29 while the transition is completed.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.

Please note, construction timelines are subject to change due to weather and other field conditions.
