



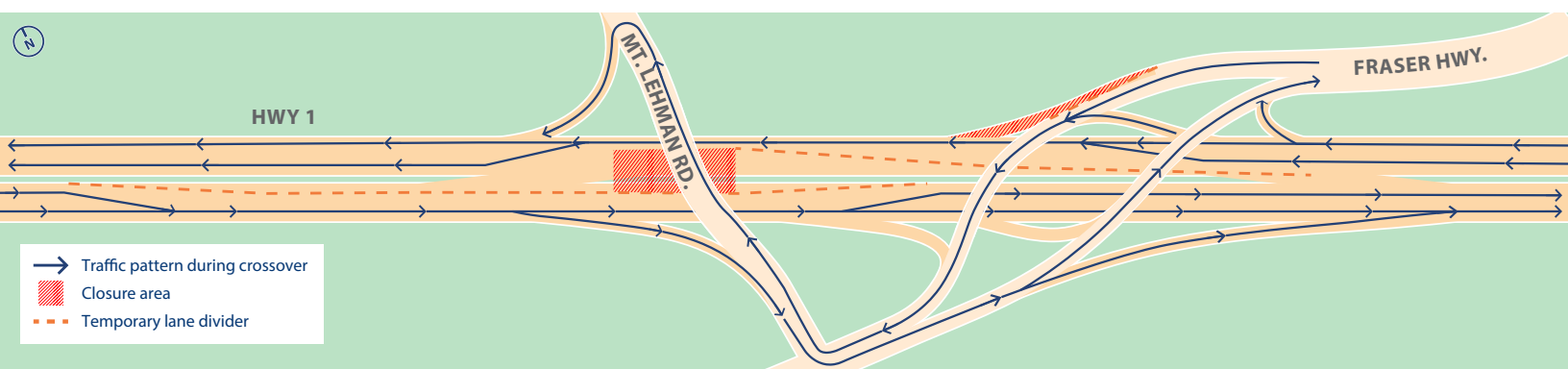

Westbound traffic pattern changes on Highway 1 at Mt Lehman Road

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes westbound on Highway 1, from Fraser Highway to Mt Lehman Road.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to safely install girders for the expanded Mt Lehman structure.

Westbound on Highway 1, from Fraser Highway to west of Mt Lehman Road.	Multiple nights, from as early as Monday, August 31 through Friday, September 11: Sunday-Thursday: 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Friday-Saturday: 8:30 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.	Westbound Highway 1 traffic will temporarily shift to travel in the exit lane. The westbound on-ramp to Highway 1 from Fraser Highway will be closed, with drivers detoured via Mt Lehman Road. All other ramps will remain open.



Please note, construction timelines are subject to change due to weather and other field conditions.
