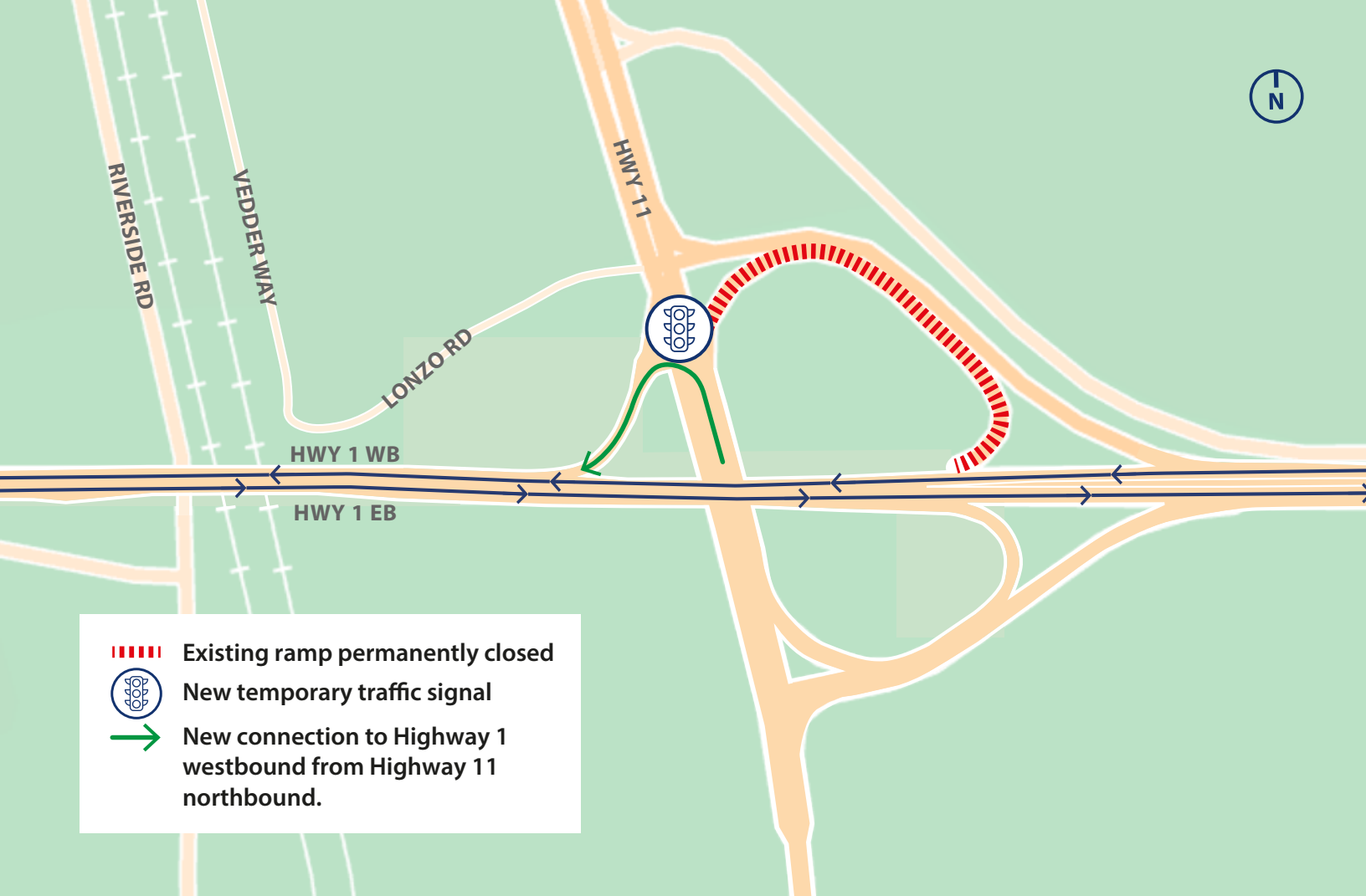
Traffic pattern changes on Highway 11 at Highway 1

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes on Highway 11.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to safely undertake construction and demolition activities as part of the Highway 11 Interchange Project.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
Highway 11 northbound to Highway 1 westbound	As early as Thursday September 10	The existing loop ramp from Highway 11 northbound to Highway 1 westbound will be permanently closed. This ramp will be replaced as part of future interchange improvements. Drivers will instead make a left turn at a new temporary traffic signal to access to Highway 1 via existing southbound on-ramp (see map on reverse). The climbing lane on Highway 1 westbound at Riverside Road will also be closed.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage and traffic-control personnel, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.

Please note, construction timelines are subject to change due to weather and other field conditions.
