Traffic pattern changes on Highway 1 at 264th Street

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes on Highway 1 at 264th Street.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to safely demolish the existing 264th Street structure.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
Highway 1 at 264th Street	Nightly from Thursday, September 10 to Tuesday, September 14: 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m.	Eastbound and westbound Highway 1 traffic will be detoured through the 264th Street Interchange's on- and off-ramps.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.
