Traffic pattern changes on 232nd Street at Highway 1

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes on 232nd Street at Highway 1.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to prepare for demolition of the existing 232nd Street structure.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
232nd Street at Highway 1	As early as Thursday, September 10	Northbound and southbound traffic on 232nd Street will be shifted onto the newly constructed roadway and structure.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.

Please note, construction timelines are subject to change due to weather and other field conditions.
