Traffic pattern changes on Highway 1 between Glover Road and 248th Street

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes on Highway 1, from Glover Road to 248th Street.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow crews to safely demolish the existing 232nd Street structure.

Westbound on Highway 1, from 248th Street to Glover Road	Saturday, September 12: 8:30 p.m. to 10:30 a.m. the following morning	Westbound Highway 1 lane diversions to implement a highway crossover. During the crossover, traffic will flow in both directions on the eastbound highway lanes. Westbound on- and off-ramps at 232nd Street will be closed.
Eastbound on Highway 1, from Glover Road to 248th Street	Saturday, September 19: 8:30 p.m. to 10:30 a.m. the following morning	Eastbound Highway 1 lane diversions to implement a highway crossover. During the crossover, traffic will flow in both directions on the westbound highway lanes. The eastbound off-ramp at 232nd Street will be closed. The eastbound on-ramp will remain open.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.

Please note, construction timelines are subject to change due to weather and other field conditions.
