Traffic pattern changes on Fraser Highway westbound at Highway 1

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of upcoming traffic pattern changes westbound on Fraser Highway at Highway 1.

These traffic pattern changes are necessary to allow ongoing construction for the highway widening and structure improvements.

WHERE	WHEN	WHAT TO EXPECT
Fraser Highway westbound on-ramp to Highway 1	Nightly from Sunday, September 13 to Thursday, September 17: 8:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.	Westbound Fraser Highway on-ramp to Highway 1 will be closed. Drivers will be detoured via the westbound Mt Lehman Road on-ramp. All other ramps will remain open.

Drivers are asked to slow down and allow extra travel time, obey signage, and watch for roadside workers.

Drivers should expect additional lane closures and other traffic pattern changes in the area as work progresses. Notifications will be sent in advance of major impacts.

Please note, construction timelines are subject to change due to weather and other field conditions.
