


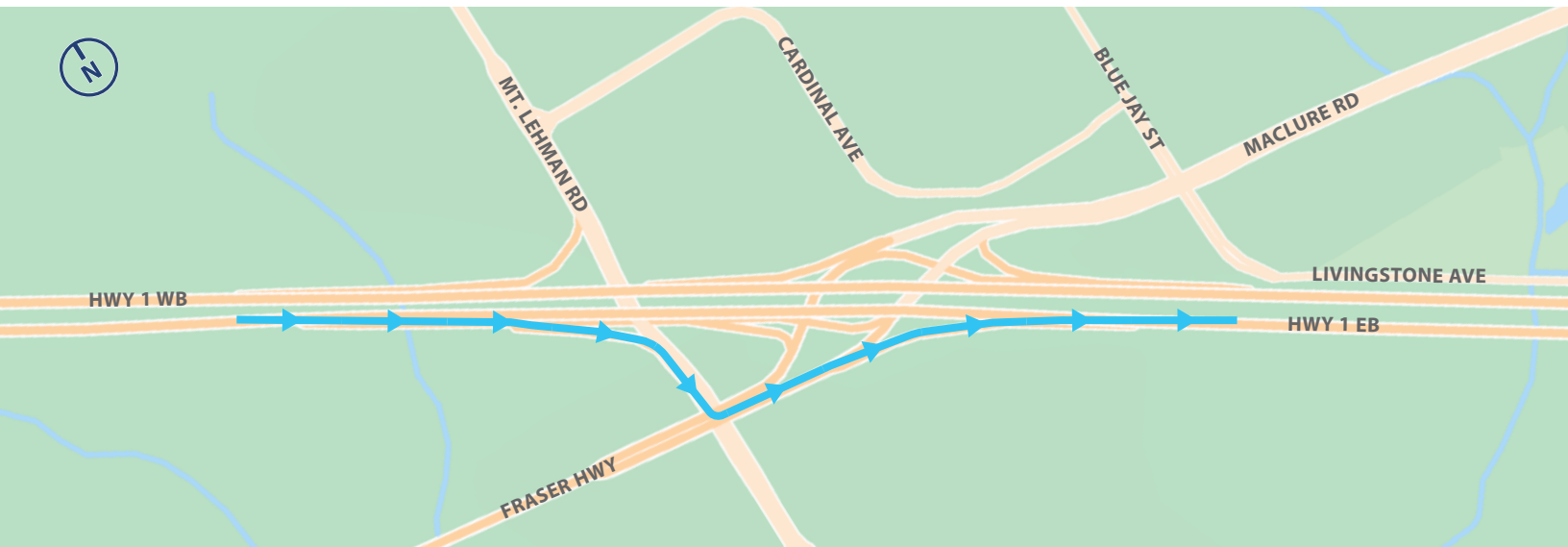


Traffic detour eastbound on Highway 1 at Mt Lehman Road

As work progresses to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers are advised of a detour eastbound on Highway 1 at Mt Lehman Road overnight on Saturday, May 30, 2026.

This detour is necessary to allow crews to prepare for an upcoming girder installation at the Mt Lehman structure and is a key component of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program.

 Eastbound on Highway 1 at Mt Lehman Road	From 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 30 to 7:30 a.m. on Sunday, May 31.	Eastbound Highway 1 closure at Mt Lehman Road. Drivers will use the exit 83 ramp to return to Highway 1 via Fraser Highway.



Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and watch for roadside workers. Please allow for additional travel time through the area when diversions are underway.
