Weekend Bradner Road Closure

Friday, June 12 at 9:00 p.m. to Monday, June 15 at 5:00 a.m.

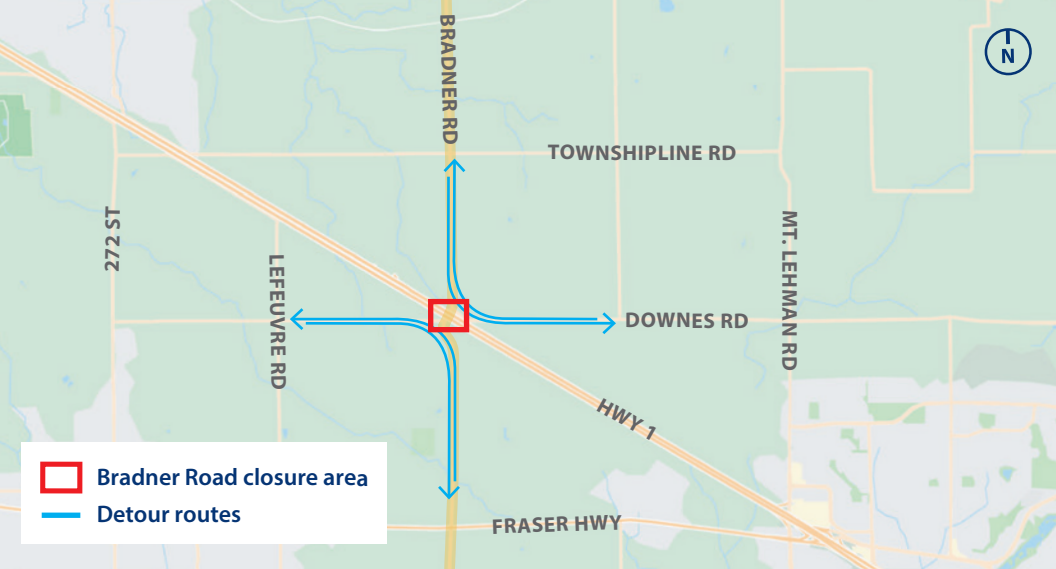
Note: in the event of unforeseen ground conditions, an additional closure may be required the following weekend, from June 19 at 9:00 p.m. to June 22 at 5:00 a.m.

As part of the broader project to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, the section of Bradner Road beneath Highway 1 is anticipated to be closed from June 12 at 9:00 p.m. to June 15 at 5:00 a.m. In the event of unforeseen ground conditions, an additional closure may be required the following weekend, from June 19 at 9:00 p.m. to June 22 at 5:00 a.m.

This closure is required to allow crews to safely install culverts under Bradner Road, which will improve drainage in the area.

Traffic Information

During the closure, traffic in both directions on Bradner Road will be directed to Downes Road, which will stay open (see map on reverse). Please follow traffic control directions and posted speed limits. *Note: FIFA World Cup may also impact traffic volumes on area roads.*
