


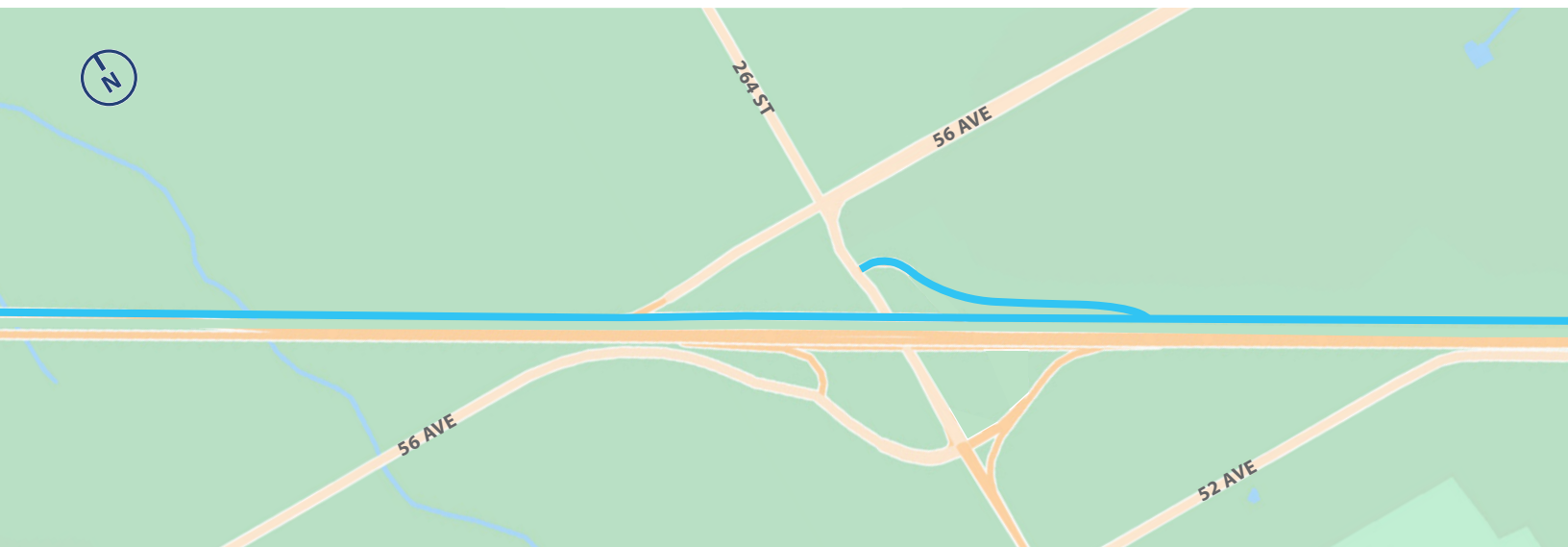


Traffic pattern change - 264th St Interchange

As part of the broader project to widen Highway 1 through the Fraser Valley, drivers travelling on Highway 1 can expect new traffic pattern changes along the corridor.

Note: FIFA World Cup may also impact traffic volumes on area roads.

 Westbound Highway 1 at the 264th Street interchange.	As early as June 12, 2026.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Westbound Highway 1 lanes will shift north. • Westbound off-ramp will shift approximately 200 m east. • Emergency services/access turnarounds are unchanged.



These changes are in addition to ongoing overnight lane closures and are needed for the safe and efficient construction of projects that are part of the Fraser Valley Highway 1 Corridor Improvement Program.

Drivers are asked to use caution, obey signage and watch for roadside workers.
