



HIGHWAY 1 KAMLOOPS TO ALBERTA FOUR-LANING PROGRAM

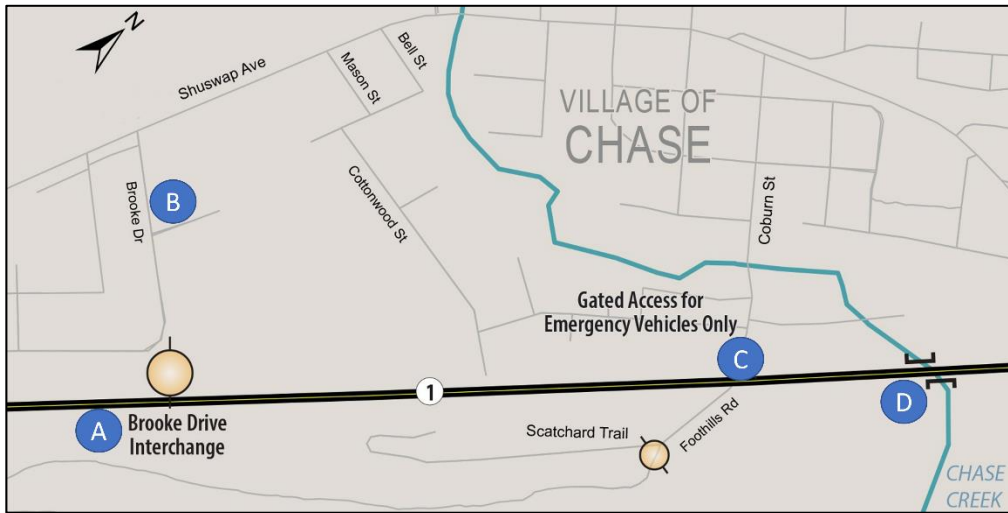
Chase East Four Laning Project - Construction and Traffic Updates June 2024

Blasting will resume mid-June 2024, with expected 5-minute closures of Highway 1.

The project is now scheduled to be completed in 2025. The timeline has been delayed due to the changing scope of work at the site. Slope stabilization needs to be completed along with remaining overpass and grading work.

The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure project team wishes to provide the public with updates on key project activities, construction, and traffic impacts to keep locals and highway users informed as the project progresses. | A | Highway through traffic | Rock stabilization work and Blasting. Expect closures of up to 5 mins in both directions along Hwy 1. |
| B | Village Roads | Upcoming work - Brooke Drive construction planned activities will include sidewalk and curb/gutter in future months. |
| C | Highway through traffic & Coburn Street Access | 7PM June 13 to 7AM June 14, Single Lane Alternating Traffic will be in place for storm sewer installation at Coburn/Foothills Coburn Street access will be closed from June 6 th to June 14 th for the installation of a storm sewer crossing the highway. |
| D | Scatchard Trail Pedestrian Traffic | Chase Creek Bridge to Foothills gravel multiuse path. Grading and final lift placement planned for June - July 2024. |
