



Chase East Four Laning Project - Construction and Traffic Updates May 2026

Chase-East Four Laning Construction is complete. Thanks to everyone in Chase for making it possible!

Since summer 2021, the Ministry of Transportation and Transit and its construction contractor CIF Construction Ltd. have been working to complete the Chase East Four Laning Project as one component of the Highway 1 – Kamloops to Alberta Four Laning Program.

The 4-year construction period expanded 1.6 kilometres of Highway 1 from two to four lanes; installed concrete median and roadside barriers to enhance traveller safety; replaced challenging intersections with a grade-separated interchange at Brooke Drive; converted the Coburn Street access for emergency services access only; and provided municipal infrastructure improvements along Brooke Drive to Shuswap Avenue, including traffic and pedestrian safety enhancements. Pedestrian connectivity improvements to the Scatchard trail were also completed.
