

Notice of Proposed R. W. Bruhn Bridge Replacement

The B.C. Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the federal Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act*, for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, the B.C. Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the online Navigable Waters Registry (cps.canada.ca) and under registry number 6662, or under Navigation Protection Program File Number 2022-507993, a description of the following work, its site and plans:

- The replacement of the R.W. Bruhn Bridge located across the Sicamous Narrows at Sicamous on Highway 1.
- The new bridge will be built on highway right-of-way downstream and directly adjacent to the north side of the existing bridge, on Highway 1 in the District of Sicamous on PID 013-840-959, Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 Plan H691, and on Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 Plan H664.
- The old bridge will be removed completely when the new bridge opens to traffic.
