Ministry and Project Partners Recognize the Second Anniversary of the Red Bridge Fire

On September 19, 2026 we mark two years since the Red Bridge, a vital connection between Tkemlúps te Secwépemc and the City of Kamloops, was destroyed by a fire. Following the initial clean up, planning has been underway on options for to improve transportation in the Kamloops area while reflecting the community's needs and respecting the cultural significance of the site.

In June, the ministry held a public engagement which drew a remarkable response. More than 6,000 responses were submitted, reflecting the community's strong interest in the connection between the two communities. All feedback is being carefully reviewed and analyzed. We want to thank everyone who took the time to participate.

We will share an update later this fall. Our three governments remain committed to progressing the planning process as quickly as possible, with the shared goal of improving transportation connections between the two communities.
